The Bankers Life Fieldhouse (formerly Consecro Fieldhouse) features a retro-style appearance evoking memories of traditional Indiana basketball fieldhouses, complemented by state-of-the-art amenities. An exciting design dominates the Fieldhouse interior. The project was completed under an extremely aggressive fast-track schedule requiring the foundations to be constructed well before the design of the superstructure was complete.

- Approximate 18,500 seating capacity.
- Two levels of suites and two concourse levels.
- Cast-in-place concrete framing system with 3 precast concrete seating bowls.
- Upper Concourse serves as special tension ring to support and constrain roof arches, saving considerable tonnage in the roof structure.
