



**St. Vincent Health Office Building  
(formerly Thomson Consumer Electronics)  
Indianapolis, Indiana**

Fink Roberts & Petrie, Inc. had the opportunity to establish a working relationship with two well-known out-of-state architects in providing the structural engineering services for the Thomson Consumer Electronics Administration Building. The architects were Haldeman Powell Johns from Dallas and Michael Graves Architects, most likely the best-known post-modern architect in the country, from New Jersey.

This new facility is a four-story braced steel frame with approximately 200,000 square feet. The original architect was Haldeman Powell Johns, during construction; Michael Graves Architects was added to the design team to redesign the lobby and the facades. Construction continued on the two wings with a gap left for the lobby area while the design was completed. Additional design features are the green and gray checkerboard precast facades on the wings and the red precast with yellow glazed brick accents which clad the lobby portion.
