The Eugene and Marilyn Eye Institute is the new home of the Indiana University School of Medicine Department of Ophthalmology. The \$20 million, 77,000 square feet, four story facility will house the adult outpatient clinic, ophthalmology classrooms, an optional shop, a basic science research center, faculty and administrative offices, graduate student meeting rooms and space for program expansion.

The Eye Institute consolidates the three missions of the Department of Ophthalmology, patient care, research and education, in a modern building of colorful glass, brick and limestone. Nearly half of the building is dedicated to research space, allowing for an increase in the number of faculty, doubling the researchers and physicians dedicated to finding solutions to vision loss.

The building is expected to meet the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED Gold specification by using energy efficient systems and building materials. The construction of the building was completed in the spring of 2011.
