Indiana University Cyber Infrastructure Building Bloomington, Indiana

The Cyber Infrastructure Building joins the IU Data Center and the IU Innovation Center in the university's evolving technology park. The \$37 million, 123,000 square feet, three-story facility is designed to be the social hub of the technology park.

The building, known as the CIB, will be home to the majority of the University Information Technology Services (UITs) staff. Its space is designed for the mobile, team-oriented work of information technology professionals. The facility, which includes a 250 person, reconfigurable multipurpose area, will serve as a central location for collaboration and sharing of resources, creating synergies among researchers, faculty, staff and students. It will also play a key role in IU's efforts to attract new technology-based opportunities and investments to Bloomington.

The CIB's design models sustainability through power savings, daylight harvesting and other measures, and will meet the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED silver certification. The construction of the building is expected to be complete in late 2011.
