The Learning Center for Columbus, Indiana is intended to serve the continuing education needs of the community for people of all ages. The project will consist of 130,000 sf, housing high tech classrooms, library, food services, an auditorium and administrative office space.

The building will serve as a bridge between the existing Ivy Tech and IUPUC buildings on the campus. A curved glass enclosed spine will serve as a public pedestrian street connecting the two facilities. The structural system will consist of a concrete flat slab for the second floor with a structural steel roof system above. Much of the structural system will remain exposed, requiring careful coordination with the architectural design.
