



**Ball State University
Art and Journalism Building
Muncie, Indiana**

The new Art and Journalism Building is located on the campus of Ball State University in Muncie, Indiana. It is entirely new construction. To blend with the existing architecture on campus, the exterior design will incorporate red brick with glass and limestone curtainwall accents.

This is the first time the University has combined its Departments of Art and Journalism under one roof. The design allocates specific space to each department while incorporating common areas where students and faculty can interact. The structure will include an art gallery, art studios, writing labs, classrooms, faculty offices, photography labs, and a food service area with dining space. A four-story atrium will be a focal point of the building. A connector to the Ball College of Communications, helping foster interaction between the art, journalism, and communications students and faculty, is a part of the project.
