

Science Engineering and Technology Buildings Indiana University/Purdue University Indianapolis, Indiana

The IUPUI Science Engineering and Technology Buildings have brought the Purdue Schools of Science, Engineering, and Technology to the Indianapolis campus of IUPUI. These three buildings have been planned, designed, and built from 1976 to 1993. With over 300,000 square feet of area, these facilities provide state-of-the-art laboratories for students and faculty alike.

Cast-in-place concrete frames were utilized on each phase to reduce the structure's natural frequency and to increase the structure's stiffness. This resulted in floors that are adequate to permit satisfactory performance of the anticipated laboratory equipment.
